

Sample Bequest Provisions

The provisions in your will for making a gift to Miss Porter's School will depend upon the type of gift and your own circumstances and interests. These model provisions may be helpful to you and your attorney. A bequest may take the form of a percentage of the estate, a dollar amount, or a specific named asset. The illustrated language below employs each of these means.

Residuary Bequest

All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, I give, devise, and bequeath to Miss Porter's School, Inc., a nonprofit secondary school in Farmington, Connecticut, for its general purposes.

Percentage Bequest
